

Ting Hsin International Group, Tingyi (Cayman Islands) Holding Corp. Scholarship Program

Outline of Scholarship

The Ting Hsin International Group, Tingyi (Cayman Islands) Holding Corp. Scholarship (hereafter referred to as the Ting Hsin Scholarship) will be granted to candidates selected through the stipulated screening process in accordance with the agreement between Ting Hsin International Group, Tingyi (Cayman Islands) Holding Corp. and Waseda University signed on October 21, 2009.

Eligibility

Applicants must fulfill all of the following requirements (1) through (4).

(1) Desire to Enter Graduate School

We seek applicants who are strongly eager to enter the Graduate School of Political Science at Waseda University as their first choice.

* It is not possible to apply for the Ting Hsin Scholarship at two or more graduate schools. If the applicant applies for two or more graduate schools at Waseda University, the applicant may lose his/her eligibility.

(2) Citizenship

Chinese Citizenship (including Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Macau)

(3) Academic Background

<For September 2012 Entrance>

The applicant must be expected to graduate from a university in China (including Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Macau) between June and September 2012.

<For April 2013 Entrance>

The applicant must be expected to graduate from a university in China (including Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Macau) between June 2012 and March 2013.

* Taiwanese applicants who served in the military after graduation in June 2010 or later are specially allowed to apply.

(4) Age

The applicant must be under the age of 30 at the time of enrolment into the Graduate School of Political Science at Waseda University.

Details of Scholarship

(1) For recipients of the Ting Hsin Scholarship, the entrance fee, tuition, and miscellaneous fees will be financed by Ting Hsin International Group, Tingyi (Cayman Islands) Holding Corp. and Waseda University during the period enrolled in Waseda University (for a maximum period of 24 months).

* Note: Tuitions and fees for non-degree subjects/courses which are not considered as basic requirements for completion of graduate school programs are not covered.

(2) JPY 1,500,000 per year will be provided for daily expenses.

Screening Method

For applicants taking examinations to enter the Graduate School of Political Science who also wish to apply for the Ting Hsin Scholarship.

Application Method

Download the "Ting Hsin Scholarship Application Form" on the website and submit it along with the rest of your application.

[Notes]

- This scholarship cannot be combined with any other scholarships offered by Waseda University or government-sponsored scholarships, including tuition waivers.
- Screening fee (5,000 yen) and remittance handling charge (2,000 yen) must be paid by applicant.
- After the first academic year, the academic performance of the recipient will continue to be assessed for one year. If the recipient is unable to maintain a satisfactory level of academic performance, the scholarship will be discontinued in the second year.
- All flight tickets and other travel expenses incurred when coming to Japan must be paid by the applicant.
- Waseda University will provide information on accommodation in Japan to successful applicants.

They should then make their own arrangements for accommodation. All fees and arrangements required thereof shall be their responsibility.

- The Ting Hsin Scholarship will only be granted to those whose status of residence is "Student" during the period enrolled in Waseda University.
